DRI professional certifications

For those wishing to acquire the <u>higher level</u> <u>certifications</u>, <u>CBCP</u>, <u>CBCV or CCRP</u>, these require proof of at least two years' professional experience in this field and payment of the <u>additional fee</u> indicated below
